Purpose of Scholarship

The purpose of our scholarship program is to attract high caliber students into the Oil & Gas Industry. The scholarships are intended to provide financial assistance to those students who might otherwise be unable to obtain a college education and to reward and recognize superior academic performance and participation in extracurricular activities

Scholarship Description

1. The scholarships are for €2,000 per student per academic year and will be paid in August at the beginning of the term.
2. The scholarships will be awarded to entering college freshman, normally graduating high school seniors.
3. The scholarships are renewable up through the fourth year (total of €8,000 per scholarship over four years).
4. Each year the SPE Netherlands Board will decide the number of new scholarships that will be awarded. The Board's decision will be based upon the funds in the Scholarship Reserve Account, projected scholarship renewals, and any other extenuating factors the Board believes important.
5. A personal interview with each of the top finalists will be conducted as part of the selection procedure.
6. Candidates for the sophomore, junior, and senior scholarships are previous SPE Netherlands Section scholarship recipients provided the student has maintained satisfactory academic progress. The program contemplates continued support of a student through four years of university study.

Qualifications for Award

1. Application for scholarship must be submitted by the student him/herself, including a photograph of the applicant (for publicity purposes only) to the SPE Netherlands Scholarship Committee, on or before the application due date of **May 31**.
2. **Applications should be send as an attachment to SPENLscholarship@spemail.org**
3. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior or entering college freshman.
4. Applicant must provide a statement that it is his/her intent to enroll in a three or four year petroleum engineering, geosciences, offshore technology engineering related program at an accredited school.
5. Applicant must provide proof to be ranked academically in the top 25% of his/her graduating class.
6. Applicant must be living and pursuing the study in the Netherlands. The scholarship is open to all nationalities providing they are willing to relocate to the Netherlands for the duration of the study.
7. The Scholarship will be cancelled if the student's program drops below the reasonable expected hours per semester or transfers out of an oilfield related program.
8. The scholarship requires a minimum Grade Point Average of 3.0/4.0 or equivalent for each year. If the student falls below this minimum at the end of an academic year, the Scholarship Committee will decide a course of action.
9. Exceptions to certain requirements may be made by the SPE Netherlands Board

Calendar

1. January - Board decides the number of new scholarships to be awarded for the next school year.
2. February / March - Solicitation for Scholarship and Applications distributed to target High Schools.
3. May 31st – Applications due.
4. August 1st - Selection and announcement of winners.
